素质教育培养素质学生!

秉承着先贤们的办学使命,韩江中学坚持以母语教学,弘扬传统文化为己任。 自2014年以来,在本校董事会同仁的前瞻教育理念下,积极打造"素质教育"的办学方针后, 从教师专业、注重学生的道德品行修养教育,并培养学生具备中文、英文及马来文的能力。 并更新提升教学设施,积极开拓不同的平台,巩固学生的学术知识及开发学生多方面的才能。

我校在制定素质教育的教学方针后,不断增添的教学设备,务求符合新时代课程的需求,并赶上科技教学技术。与此同时我校也不断提高师资专业,除了积极鼓励、推动和培训教师进修之外,也聘请具有高学历的专业教师,并严格视察教师的教学质量以提升学术水平。

近几年来,无论在学术、联课或体育,学生都有丰硕的成就,无疑证明了校方的教师专业、教学质量和学生的素质已达到素质教育目标。这让师长欣慰的同时,也让校方引以为荣,因此未来将更坚定"素质教育"的目标,继续开发学生的潜能。

在学术方面,在设备和教材的连年不断增添及师资培训下,我校学生连续在统考、SPM及IGCSE考试中和国内外的学术赛会中纷纷取得标青亮眼的成绩。如郭子瑗同学于2016年高中统考及SPM考试中分别考获各10A优秀成绩,获得国立台湾大学及新加坡南洋理工大学录取就读。

而何嘉营同学、卓佳澄同学和林俊延同学分别一举摘下2016年IGCSE 10A优异成绩,当中何嘉营同学更在英语一科中缔造全球最高分记录。

于2017年的IGCSE考试中, 黄秋恩同学除了考到10A大 的人才培养成果。

满贯之外,英语分数还荣膺全马之冠。而王嘉燕、何皓宇、王炜、张露芸和林欣宜同学也不遑多让,分别取得10A优秀成绩。

另外, 陈映如同学除了考取8A佳绩, 其数学还获得全球最高分数荣誉。

而这两年的IGCSE考试中,考获9A以下的我校学生人数更是连年增加,这印证了校方所推动的素质教育成果。

除此之外,这几年我校学生们在校内外各项学术考试及竞赛中都分别囊括佳绩,比如在世界学者杯的赛会中,我校学生连续3年在区域赛、国际赛及精英赛共夺下314金牌、469银牌和2铜牌;另外,在2015年区域赛也夺得初中组及高中组全场季军;精英赛全球19名。2017年的区域赛,我校学生也拿下11座个人组第19名。2017年的区域赛,我校学生也拿下11座个人组第5名、维文年组第2名、作文个人组第5名、初中写作组第9名杯;国际赛夺得特佳写作奖;精英赛赢得全球高中作文组第2名、作文个人组第5名、初中写作组第9名及最佳学者第10名。从学生能走出校门国门,放明世界,立足全球。这些在世界赛会的平台中取得优异的成绩可以印证,这些荣耀,是我校教育注重三语并重的人才培养成果。





另外,我校学生在国际学术考试项目中都取得杰出的成绩,比如每年的ICAS项目中,学生分别在英文、英文写作、科学及数学都会赢得金牌;在每一年的澳洲ASMO和SASMO数学比赛中,我校学生也有丰富收获,也取得金奖。

我校英语辩论队在这四年南征北伐,除了在2015年至2017年连续3届囊括"精英大学国际华文中学英语销论比赛"冠军,谢宏谘同学还赢得最佳辩论员奖。于刚刚结束的"第7届精英大学国际华文中学英语思比赛"北马区赛圈中,我校学生也拿评论队也打解见时,我校学生也拿辩论队也打解现后,在《第19届全槟福建常年杯中学生华语辩论比赛》一举击退各校辩论高手,荣膺冠军的同时,陈佳威及朱芫嶙同学夺得最佳辩论员奖项。在今年度福联青华语辩论赛槟州对垒赛中荣膺槟州区总冠军、最佳团队精神奖及谢宏谘拿下最佳辩手奖。

在州际及全国三语演讲赛会中,我校谢枟谘同学和黄 芊芊同学更是赛场常胜军,屡屡夺下前三名奖项,几 年来在相关赛会所夺得奖项不计其数,是同学们学习 的好榜样。

至于联课及体育成果方面,除了个别学生在游泳、保龄球、国标舞等和赛场上扬威,夺奖凯旋归之外,我校合唱团、戏剧社、舞蹈社、华乐团、二十四节令鼓队、舞龙队、流行音乐社、田径队、绿色教育学会、

跆拳道学会、棋艺学会等也在州际赛会、全国赛会及国际赛会中屡屡夺奖,奖项之多不胜枚举,连不是比赛团体的大众传播学会也夺得2017年精英大学全国中学刊物赛亚军,可见我校学生们的素质绝对是优秀的,能力和才艺是顶尖的。

学生在学术表现中有好收获,除了学生们努力地付出,也是我校董事会、教师教练、家协及校友组织齐心合力推动素质教育的成果。因此校方将继续秉承这个教育方针,培育更多品学兼优的优质学生。



改变,从自律开始

人生要有所改变,免不了要提到自律,唯有自律,才能做出改变。 我们身为教书匠,身为学生,也必须自律地尽本分,扮演好自己的角色。 以下的资料并不是我所写,而是在脸书上看到的好文章,我整理了之后,与大家分享。

多少人羡慕着别人的身材与样貌,羡慕着别人的成功与精彩。但是当了解到其背后付出的艰辛和近乎残酷的自我管理后,又迅速打退堂鼓。在浑浑噩噩、随波逐流的日子里,继续毫无意义地耗费生命。其实,最深刻的错误认识是,以为自由就是想做什么就做什么,但其实是自律者才会有自由。

当一个人缺乏自律的时候,他做的事情总是在受习惯和即时诱惑的影响,要么就是被他人的思想观念所扰,几乎永远不可能去做内心真正渴望的事。而那些自律到极致的人,都有了开挂的人生。

拿一个例子吧, 谷歌有位高级工程师马特卡茨, 他给 自己定下了一个30天改变的计划,每天做一些之前未 能坚持的事。比如每天骑自行车上班,每天步行1万 步,每天拍一张照片,写一本5万字的小说:不看电 视,不吃糖,不玩推特,拒绝咖啡因……可以说这份 计划充满了挑战性, 做不到自律的人势必无法完成。 但马特坚持了下来。30天后,昔日那个肥腻的宅男工 程师不见了, 他开始发自内心地喜欢上骑自行车去工 作, 甚至完成了在非洲最高峰乞力马扎罗山的远足。 心理学家曾经总结过这样的规律, 自律的前期是兴奋 的,中期是痛苦的,后期是享受的。但大部分人都在 自律的中期——痛苦期徘徊太久,以至於把痛苦当作 是自律。而当你自律到极致, 你会发现, 自律能够带 给你发自内心的平静和享受。你会发现, 自己在一天 天地改变, 自律已经变成了一种深入骨髓的习惯。《 少有人走的路》里有这样一句话:解决人生问题的首 要方案, 乃是自律。缺少了这一环, 你不可能解决任 何麻烦和困难。

那么,我们身为老师和学生,需要如何自律?需要改变什么呢?

1.设立具体目标,坚持无一例外原则。

无数研究显示: 当人们用具体的条文对他们的目标进行定义后, 他们成功的可能性就会大大增加。比如说

我们可以设立以下的目标:

- (a) 不贿赂警察, 当你犯下交通规则, 就必须领罚单
- (b) 吃完快餐之后, 自己清理干净桌子上的垃圾。
- (c) 多说"请"和"谢谢"。
- (d) 练习准时
- (e) 学习做垃圾分类

2.一次只完成一项任务,不过多消耗毅力。

在改变自己的道路上,许多人会一次性给自己定下太多目标:比如,半年内练出马甲线、考过XX考试、看50本书、看美剧不需要字幕.....然而,毅力就像人的肌肉一样,会产生疲劳。同时接受太多挑战,通常无法坚持实施下去。当完成一个任务所需的时间跨度很长、难度很大时,许多人容易半途而费。这个时候,需要学会对任务进行分解。

3.把挑战分解成小而易於管理的目标。

为运动会注入新元素

今年韩中运动会恢复以色队进行。

终于在4月28日,迎来了以红黄蓝青紫的第62届韩中运动会。青队以最整齐的队型,获得色队步操比赛冠军。红队也在啦啦队比赛中加入了多种元素,脱颖而出,荣获啦啦队比赛冠军。

在预赛后,分数落后的情况下,蓝队在运动会决赛中,迎头赶上,以306分,20金、14银及9铜,拿下了全场总冠军;紫队以16金14银18铜获得全场亚军;青队以金24银和18铜获得全场季军。

在校外比赛中,本校小飞鱼何嘉漩以3金3银2铜获得了全国女子18岁以下最佳泳手,并以7金及刷新全槟

女子18岁以下100米蝶泳的记录,获得全场最佳泳手及女子18岁以下组最佳泳手。与此同时,涂峻玮也以6金3银及打破全槟男子18岁以下200M 蛙式记录,荣获男子18岁以下组最佳泳手。

Learning Through Activity prepared by∎Kesavaani Kandasamy

The session was conducted by Ms. Jasamine on the 29th of December 2017. The main objective of the training was to train the teachers to use multiple learning strategies in teaching.

According to Ms. Jasamine, there are varieties of strategies that a teacher can bring into play in order to draw and grab the students attention. In this training session, she shared plenty strategies whereby the teacher can utilize them in order to make the class more engaging and lively.

Activity 1: 'Yes/No/Maybe...Not Much'

The training started off with 'Yes/No/Maybe...Not Much' activity. The aim of this activity is to encourage the teachers to know the students better. In this activity, she stuck 'Yes/No/Maybe...Not Much' words on different parts of wall. Then, the teachers were required to read out sentence from the screen and run to different parts of the room that denotes their answer. Peers asked questions and elicited some explanation to their answer.

Activity 2: Grammar Ground

After that, a large piece of mahjong paper was placed on each flip chart. There were five sentences on each flip chart. We were required to walk around the class and read all the sentences on the flip chart and stand next to the flip chart that best describes oneself.

Activity 3: Basket Case Teacher

Teachers are obligated to bring items about our self and

use the items by asking the students to describe 'ME'. This activity will aid the students for descriptive writing.

Activity 4: Candy Mania

Teachers were required to take as many candies from the box as they like. After everybody in the room has taken the candies, they counted the number of candies they have and revealed to group member. The person with the highest number of candy in the group told the others about themselves (according to the number of candies taken!)

Activity 5: Homerun

In this task, the teachers were divided into two groups and given each with comic strips. When the instructor shouts out a word from the handout, the teachers were required to scan for the word and shout them out quickly. Then, they were quizzed with three questions.

Activity 6: Solitaire

The teachers worked in two teams. Each team was asked to select two numbers from the box. Then, the instructor wrote words in the two boxes and cleaned them up. Subsequently, the next person from another group said the next two letters. This activity took around 25 minutes to complete as the teachers took some time to find and pair 14 compound adjectives.

Finally, the teachers were requested to create an activity that can be carried out in pairs, whole class or groups. The teachers designed their own activity and present them in front of the class.

Understanding the Three Components in IGCSE Examinations

The Speaking session was conducted to ensure that the speaking test held internally adhered to the guidelines set by Cambridge International Examinations. This includes the manner of which the test is conducted and that the grades given by examiners are deserving to the standards of the Cambridge IGCSE English as a Second Language speaking test.

The session covered all the necessary aspects of the speaking test including the conduct and recording of the test to ensure that the speaking test emulates the actual test by the Cambridge International Examinations. It covered parts of the test; from the start of the recording to the warm up section and main part of the test. The session also addressed questions and provided ideas as well as a step by step guide to conduct the test. Trainees listened to sample test recordings and were guided on the marking criteria.

By the end of the session, trainees understood the standards required and it's marking criteria. This ensures that the marks are valid and consistent to that of the

Cambridge International Examinations standards.

The Reading and Writing session was conducted to ensure that test held internally adhered to the guidelines set by Cambridge International Examinations. This includes the manner of which the questions are chosen and set and that the grades given by examiners are deserving to the standards of the Cambridge IGCSE English as a Second Language reading and writing test.

The session covered all 7 parts in the reading and writing test; from Exercise 1 to Exercise 7. The session also addressed sample questions and marking criteria for each part of the test. Trainees took note of sample past year papers with answers and were walked through on the marking criteria.

By the end of the session, trainees understood the marking criteria and standards required by the IGCSE ESL examination. This ensures that the marks are valid and consistent to that of the Cambridge International Examinations parts.



2017 WSC Tournament of Champions Report

The World Scholars Cup is an academic competition that Han Chiang has attended for the four time, as of 2018. The program has attracted the attention of students since 2015, and has undoubtedly not ceased to do so, due to a variety of reasons. The two predominant factors which account for Han Chiang's growing in the World Scholar's Cup is the fun nature of the competition, and the wide scope of curriculum and abilities involved. Reconciling the two gives way to an academic competition that exercises all sorts of skills from writing to speaking to alpaca-balancing, and encourages learning about the world around us and the things that aren't discussed or even mentioned within the school, all in an exciting, convivial environment that celebrates not only making learning fun, but also diversity, culture, and self-discovery. There are four main events in the World Scholar's Cup: Team Debate, Scholar's Challenge, Collaborative Writing, and Scholar's Bowl.

On the 9th to 14th of November 2017, Han Chiang sent seven scholars and two teachers to Yale University, USA, to attend the 10th annual World Scholar's Cup Tournament of Champions. The seven scholars were Sarah Swea, Lee Jie (J3E1) in the Junior division, Ng Yee Thern, Lee Cheng Jie, Amelia Chong (SE21), Jennalynn Lam (CV3), and Teoh Tze Han (CE21) in the Senior division, while Mr. Samuel Ong and Ms. Yeoh Chia Ying chaperoned the scholars. The delegation arrived in John F. Kennedy

Airport on the 6th, and departed from the airport on the 17th of November, inclusive a three-day trip to Manhattan, New York following the competition.

The seven scholars jointly achieved a total of 43 gold medals, 26 silver medals, and 5 trophies. Out of approximately 1500 juniors, Sarah won back 10th place overall, while Yee Thern won 46th among a thousand seniors. The junior top team, Sarah and Lee Jie, won 15th place overall trophy, 2nd place regional trophy, and 9th place writing trophy. The senior top team, Yee Thern, Cheng Jie, and Amelia, won 23rd place overall gold, 4th place regional trophy, and 2nd place writing trophy; Cheng Jie received 5th place individual writing trophy. Except for Sarah, all participants were attending the Tournament of Champions for the first time. Hopefully 2018 calls for a larger wave of HC participants.



Interclass Debate Competition

The interclass Debate Competition is an annual event organised by Han Chiang High School. The preliminary round was held on the 21st March 2018, with a total of 36 participants. There were 8 teams of junior students and 4 teams of senior students. They were divided into categories A and B for seniors and juniors respectively. WSC Regional Round Report

The 30th and 31st of March saw ninety scholars from Han Chiang High School taking part in the annual Regional Round of the World Scholar's Cup, held in Prince of Wales Island International School (POWIIS) and Universiti Sains Malaysia. This year's was the largest-ever regional round held in Malaysia, with nearly 450 scholars participating. Yet Han Chiang's scholars were delirious, returning with an abundance of medals and a chance take on the Global Round in Kuala Lumpur.

The academic competition of the World Scholar's Cup itself consists of four events: the Scholar's Challenge, Collaborative Writing, Team Debates, and the Scholar's Bowl, bringing together six subjects dealing with global current affairs, which scholars must master in order to perform well. Scholars hailing from differing cultures and lifestyles mingle across competitive and social events alike.

Among the Han Chiang scholars, two particular individuals stand out: Rhowan Ho Rui Yang and Sarah Swea Enqing, who both claimed the School Top Scholar accolades in the Junior and Senior divisions respectively. Two teams emerged as the strongest suit of Han Chiang's teams — Ung Pei Juin, Nicole Sim Kai Xin, and Tan Han-Jo in the junior division, with Sarah Swea and Lee Jie along with their third teammate from Sunway College in the senior division. The two teams performed exceptionally well and obtained trophies for second place Champion Teams in their respective divisions.

Apart from that, Sarah and Hoven also scored highest in their respective divisions for the Scholar's Challenge, which is widely regarded as the most difficult event of the competition, and attained the Isaac Asimov prizes, which were debuted in the Penang Round. Additionally, Sarah broke the seasonal record for the Challenge, having achieved the highest score in the world at the time of

writing.

adorned them, adding up to a staggering 369 medals and 18 trophies. Expressing astonishment, Rhowan stated that the stellar

achievements were a pleasant surprise for him, given that this was only his second year attending the program. In his two years of attending the program, Rhowan says that the World Scholar's Cup has helped with learning how to focus on his priorities. His achievements have inspired him to become an exemplar for excelling scholars in the

upcoming Global Round.

While Sarah has been involved in the program for three years, this has been the first year she's attended as a senior. She initially joined the senior division just to test the waters, but nevertheless managed to achieve ground breaking results once again. Having studied as early as December, Sarah has worked extremely hard to prepare for this competition. She admits that balancing the World Scholar's Cup and the rest of her life has proven to be quite the task, especially considering she fell sick a while before Regionals, but that she thinks the program is worth the effort; year after year, the program has proven to be more than a competition; a staff more than an organizing board; a community more than fellow peers. The World Scholar's Cup has become her family — a family she wishes to stay with forever.

Mr. Samuel Ong has been coaching the scholar community in Han Chiang for four years, ever since the school joined the program back in 2015. Alternatively the quantity of scholars has indeed increased, he believes that the quality has not lagged behind either. He says that he, once again, was extremely proud of his scholars this round, but also slightly worried about the first-timers in the program. Nonetheless, he will continue to coach them and guide them on the ambitious journey of excelling in the program. The World Scholar's Cup has become an integral part of his life, and he doesn't see himself ending this commitment anytime soon.

Seminar of Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is a common framework for language programmes and for the education of language teachers. It is best known for the proficiency scale from A1 to C2, and for the descriptors of achievement expressed in the form of "can do" statements. As a common framework, the CEFR can be used to organise the curriculum, teaching and learning including learning materials, and assessment. The main objective of the CEFR seminar was to improve the English Language proficiency of Malaysian students and teachers in terms of curriculum, teaching and learning as well as assessment.

According to CEFR, what is assessed, and how performance is interpreted are key concerns for the framework. There are three main ways in which the CEFR can be used in assessment (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, Teaching, Assessment, Council of Europe, p. 178):

- 1. specifying the content of tests and examinations: what is assessed.
- 2. stating the criteria to determine the attainment of a learning objective: how performance is interpreted,
- 3. describing the levels of proficiency in existing tests and examinations thus enabling comparisons to be made across different systems of qualifications: how comparisons can be made.

Even though assessments may take many forms in different parts of the world, having a set of common standards such as the CEFR gives an advantage as it makes it possible to relate different forms of assessment and their results to one another using these common standards.

The difference between the Malaysian English Language curriculum and the CEFR is that Malaysian examinations at the secondary school level assess the four language skills to varying degrees and do not provide equal emphasis on the four skills. They largely assess the skills of reading and writing, and for this reason, teachers tend to prioritise these skills over listening and speaking in the classroom.

The CEFR, however, is based on performance in a language and therefore places emphasis on all four skills. The call to align the Malaysian English Language curriculum to the CEFR poses a challenge to the way proficiency in English is assessed in secondary schools. Based on the CEFR descriptors, the performance of students in all the four language skills should be assessed.

According to CEFR, what we need is a system of remedial English language education which is not an add-on to the main programme, but part of the main programme itself. Children should not be allowed to fail in English and then given support to help them recover from failures but should be given support to stop them failing in the first place.

Ensuring quality of Speaking and Listening Test in PT3 prepare

The session was attended by Miss Angelina Carrel a/p Arlanda (English teacher) and Puan Choy Way Boon (Head of Bahasa Malaysia).

The session was conducted to ensure that the PT3 Speaking and Listening Test that will be held internally are in accordance with the guidelines set by the Exam Board of Malaysia. This includes the security of the papers which have been downloaded from the question bank of the examination board. Action in accordance to the Act of Examination will be taken upon the Principal, Head of Department and teachers who do not follow the rules of the School Based Examination.

The session covered all the necessary aspects of the Speaking and Listening Test which includes the dates of the examination. Every school should conduct the Speaking Test from 1st April to 30th April 2018, and the Listening Test on 14th August 2018 for their candidates. Besides the

examination dates, the session also mentioned the other dates for downloading the papers, and modification by PKW - Pentaksir Kawasan.

Meanwhile, the Speaking Test is divided into two parts. The first part is reading aloud (10%) and the second part is spoken interaction (20%). Both of the sections will last for about 10-12 minutes. For Listening Test, the schools will receive the audio from the Examination Board and ensure that there are no technical problems during examination. The layout of the examination room for both tests were also mentioned.

By the end of the session, participants understood the standards required and the procedures of the PT3 Examination. This ensures that the school based examination is valid and consistent throughout the schools in Malaysia.

Communicative Activities that Get Students Talking

On the 6th of May, some of our teachers attended a workshop facilitated by Rose Graves. Rose is an English language teacher from California, USA. She has taught English for the past 14 years, at community colleges in the US, at refugee camp schools on the Thai/Burma border in public middle and high schools in Japan, as a Peace Corps teacher trainer in Ecuador, and as an English Language Fellow in Bangka Belitung, near Sumatra, Indonesia.

Session 1: Helping Students Enjoy Reading

Extensive reading has been a popular topic in TESOL in recent years. Regardless of the length of the material or the level of the student-from a short paragraph to a novel- the guiding principle of extensive reading is that it is done for enjoyment. In this workshop the facilitator has given some in-class strategies to support students reading outside the classroom, and how to help students to become active and engaged readers.

Session 2: Designing Activities for a Communicative Classroom

This workshop focused on how teachers can create a communicative classroom by designing activities that encourage authentic and meaningful interaction among students. This workshop also discussed some of the principles of good communicative activities, and based on hands-on and interactive lesson.

The training started off with 'Clap Clap, Snap Snap...' activity. The aim of this activity is to review new words in a fun way. In this activity, the facilitator chose a topic

on fruits and asked the trainees to stand in a circle of four. Trainees were asked to think a name of a fruit while clapping and say the word by snapping. This activity goes on until someone repeats the word. (Tip: don't clap too fast!) Students need time to think of a new word.

After that, participants were shown a picture and asked to create a dialogue between two people.

Partner A: describe what happened before the picture was taken Partner B: describe what happened after the picture was taken

Participants were required to work in pairs by choosing a Person A and a Person B in each pair. Person A was given 1 minute to tell Person B as many details as possible about his/her family. Person B has to remember the details of Person A's family and he/she was given 30 seconds to tell Person A as much information about the family that they can remember.

Last step: Person B's turn to talk about their family! (Repeat the same procedure.)

Then, there was the Collaborative Poetry (Diamond Poem). The facilitator explained the format of the poem: 7 line long, begin and end with antonyms, each line uses a different part of speech. Participants were shown some examples of diamond poems and were asked to write a diamond poem with a partner. In this task, the facilitator got the participants to read their poems and encouraged teachers to use this activity in the classroom as students can learn to make lists of words related to a subject of interest and foster students' creativity in writing.

UEC English Examination Workshop

During the workshop, the students were guided on what they should know, the common mistakes done by students and the do's and don'ts when answering questions. This workshop had also given students the extra confidence in answeing their exam. Overall, the UEC workshop managed to provide useful examination tips and answering techniques that will help the students to perform well in their upcoming examinations.

Indisputable Champions of Han Chiang's

Another victory was won by Han Chiang's debate team in the Northern Zone preliminary round of the 7th International Debate Competition held by HELP University on 21st April 2017. Debaters Lim Le Ying, Thow Liren (SE11), Sarah Swea, and Ung Pei Juin (J3E1) faced off against Chong Hwa Private School and Phor Tay Private School, debating on the two motions "This house believes that the client should always be right" and "This house prefers high oil prices to lower ones" respectively. After winning both rounds unanimously, the team will proceed to the final round in July at Kuala Lumpur.

This is not the first time Han Chiang has performed spectacularly in HELP debate competitions — last year in 2017, Han Chiang secured the HELP Debate challenge trophy permanently after winning the competition for three consecutive years: 2015, 2016, and 2017.

In 2016, Han Chiang's team who consisted of Bryan Ng (2016 J21), Ryan Ng (2016 CV1), Jordan Cheah (2016 CE2), and Joyce Wong (2016 SE2) qualified for the finals in Kuala Lumpur. On the 16th and 17th of July, they debated with Chung Hwa High School in the octofinals with a unanimous win, and in the semi-finals, they debated against Hin Hua High School and won with a slim 3–2 in our favour. For the final round, they debated against Chung Ling Private High School and were given a mere hour to prepare for the final round. They were then crowned champions with a unanimous decision across all nine judges.

Just last year in 2017, a team comprised by Ng Yee Thern, Yap Jiong Yan, and Katherine Cheah (2017 SE11) emerged as champions of the Northern Zone preliminary round for the third consecutive year and advanced to the final round on the 12th and 13th of August. There, they debated in the octo-finals and quarter-finals on the first day and on the 13th, they faced off against Hin Hua High School in the semi-finals and Poi Lam High School in the final

round, with an hour allocated for preparation time, as both motions were released only an hour before the matches. As this year's team was preparing for the Northern round, they encountered little hardships and worked well with each other, although they faced minor problems and had to rewrite a speech in one instance, which was not very easy considering they had to speak for eight minutes. Mr Samuel and Mr Oliver as debate coaches were great help when the team did face difficulties. Having received assistance and training from professionals, the team's preparation process was relatively smooth.

Le Ying expressed that her initial goal was just to qualify for the final round in Kuala Lumpur, and she didn't expect to do so well in the Northern round. She had some trouble understanding the motion, but with help from her teammates, all turned out well. She also hopes to win for Han Chiang once again. Since this is her first time doing simultaneous parliamentary debate, she hopes that she can do just as well as she usually does in debates, if not better. With the Northern round not only being the first HELP round but the first real debate tournament and competitive Asian parliamentary debate that Sarah has joined, she was nervous about the competition. She thinks that it was more overwhelming before than during the debates, as she realised her opponents were equally as nervous and inexperienced. Despite that, she definitely feels the pressure of Han Chiang's legacy on her, especially because she looks up so much to her debating seniors who had created this legacy. Nonetheless, she feels privileged to get to know and learn from them. It feels surreal that it's on them, a previously completely inexperienced team, to deliver the same results. With that said, although the increasingly difficult progression of future rounds may prove to be slightly worrying for her, Sarah is confident that her team will pull through once again.



In case you were wondering about why he left and came back later on, according to Mr. P'ng, his cousin had asked him to help out at his business of manufacturing and retailing menswear a few years before the December of 2010. 
感谢各界慷慨解囊

两年内的3次大水灾,让我校遭受前所未有的惨重损失,所幸,除了得到州政府的关注,给予拨款协助外,槟榔屿韩江校友会总会、各地分会、各届毕业校友、家协成员、姐妹校宽柔中学、全体师生和家长们同心协力,捐钱出力打扫,以求尽速恢复舒适美丽的学习环境,让学生能够安心求学。

我校姐妹校新山宽柔中学及古来分校,除了 立即给予慰问之外,也伸出援手发动全校筹 款,为遭遇水灾的我校给予援助。

另外,还有一位不愿具名的善心人士,主动资助我校重修校舍,把图书馆地板垫高之余,也把部分空间修建为课室,纾解了校方不够课室使用的苦恼,让校方极为感激。

当然,来自各界的善心人士、公司企业、机构单位、组织、务消防队和各报社,也纷请 慷慨解囊,甚至出钱出力,发动人手携带员 无短暂的时被复原状,使学生们 计短短的时间内恢复原状,使学生们 于组织 惊天地在下净舒适的接手的各界人士组妹校方 表次 校友们、家协成员、家长们和姐妹校宽、校文的关系中学,并对他们的善举致谢。



捐款用在修复校园

社会大众的捐献,校方都用于翻修校舍、 更新器材、增添设备和重建电脑系统等

修复学校的设备,如水沟、围栏、马路 等。深阔的水沟是舒缓水流的关键,以备 遇上暴雨和水患时, 能够有效发挥排水的

篱笆围栏在大水灾时被冲坏, 因此校方使 用了更稳固的建材,确保日后可抵挡来自 水患的冲力。与此同时, 校方也翻新了校 舍的屋顶, 以免雨后发生漏水。

经过这3次水灾后,底楼课室与办公室设 备如智能教学板、铁橱、桌子、椅子等, 都不幸遭殃。底楼办公室与部门的情况最 为严重,文件资料已被浸坏,为了避免水 患的破坏, 校方不得不将联课处、体育 处、训育处与辅导处都迁移至二楼。

我校贩卖部更是重灾区, 为了应付新学年 才购买的书籍、课本、簿子与文具,即使 为了预防水患而垫高,但也无济于事,几 乎所有都被浸坏,因此校方最终重新规 划,把贩卖部搬迁至地势较高的忠义科学 馆底楼。

此外, 音乐室里不少乐器也被水浸坏, 包 括喇叭、大提琴、钢琴等等, 所以校方 也在音乐楼的4间活动室进行了修复和装 修, 让学生可以在更舒适的环境下进行联 课活动。装修工程包括铺垫木地板以及油 漆墙壁。

校方总共耗费了大约35万令吉来重购书 本、教学器材、办公室设备和铜乐队受损

经过这次的校园大翻修,采取抗灾步骤和 方案之后,相信校方遭遇淹水的机率将会 更低。





重新规划校舍防灾祸

另外, 图书馆的部分书籍都被洪水浸坏了, 使许多珍贵的书籍 逼不得已必须丢弃。为了避免水魔的再次肆虐,校方增建了假 楼,把藏书都置放于高处,以避免书籍再次浸水。

校方也在需使用乐器的活动室内置放铁厨,并指示学生将乐器 放在第三层, 把乐器的袋子放在第二层, 再将自己的书包放在 第一层,以减少乐器再被浸坏的机率,把损失降到最低。

校方也扩建了舞蹈室,以便同学们有更多空间练舞。

虽然忠义科学馆地势较高,在前两次逃过厄运的学记室和电脑 室,在第三次的全槟大水灾中终无法幸免于难,尤其是电脑系 统与电脑也近乎灭顶, 所以校方不得不把学记室、电脑室及多 媒体办公室都搬迁至3楼,并耗费60万令吉重新修建电脑系统和 购买电脑。

在迁移学记室、电脑室及多媒体办公室后, 校方也在忠义科学 馆底楼改建了3间新课室,一间管乐室和贩卖部。此外,图书馆 的阅读空间和原本的联课处、体育处、训育处和辅导处空间都 被改建成新的教室,以应付不断增加的学生人数。



江校长: 学生须正视水患危险



美国校园枪击案

根据CNN的报导,今年2月14日及5月18日,美国的Florida州和Texas州的中学分别发生校园枪击案,两宗案件共造成了逾60人伤亡的悲剧,而肇事者皆为相关中学的学生。

根据美国媒体报导,自2013以来,枪击案件已多达290宗,而所有枪击案中死亡人数占季军宝座的便是于2007年发生在Virginia Tech University的校园枪击案,死亡人数多达32人,仅次的是2012年Sandy Hook小学枪击案,多达26人死亡。

资料分析,在大型枪击案1077位死者中,176位为小孩或青少年。总共292把枪击案件中所使用的枪支,167把为合法途径所得,49把为非法途径所得,其他76把所得途径不明。而153位枪手里,一些枪手拥有暴力倾向或犯罪历史,一些则行为正常直至犯案。而其中仅有3位女性,大部分处于20岁至49岁之间。88位枪手死于现场或现场附件,或选择自杀。然而,校园枪击案虽骇人听闻,但其实仅占了所有枪击案的一小部分。一般上,美国境内发生枪击案的地点最多在办公室以及零售店、餐馆及商店。

枪击案频繁发生之因

据University of Alabama的Adam Lankford教授在2015年的研究,枪击案频繁发生的原因仅是因为拥有过多的枪支。美国人口占全球总人口约4.4%,却拥有全世界42%的枪支,因此发生枪击案的机率也提高。他发现,一个国家的拥有枪支率与大规模枪击案的发生机率相关,这是他在对照各国枪击案发率后的结论,意味着以获取枪支的难易度来解释枪击案的发生,比以暴力水平评估更为合理。而人民拥有过多枪

支的根源便是其宪法制度的问题。由于宪法的过于宽 松放纵,民众可轻易通过合法途径获得枪支,枪支的 滥用程度亦会随之提高,而罪犯也可更容易地获得枪 支,造成枪击案的频繁发生。

此外,美国人民拥有的枪械数量无法减少的原因是近年来越来越多的美国人倾向于支持拥有枪支权,认为枪支为自卫最佳的武器之一。部分民众认为当多番劝告无法奏效时,以暴制暴便是最佳的解决方案;有部分民众则坚信严厉控制申请枪支拥有许可证条文,严厉执法才是解决枪击案频繁发生的方法。

Florida枪击案发生后,激起了美国民众的怒火,尤其是青少年更发起示威集会,呼吁国会关注并撤销摊抢法案。但美国国会仍未依民众的建议和不满作出改动,甚至为了选票的美国总统特朗普的第一他次有直接提及"枪支控制"或任何有关争议,他只含糊其辞,答应会"帮助学校获得安全保障,并解决合理、精神疾病问题",忽视了真正的问题所在,导致问题根源无法被彻底清除。这证明了美国政府无意的制裁,因为他们作出任何巨大的改动均会引起极大的激荡。



枪击案无关暴力游戏

某位接受本校学记访问的美国匿名网民指出,就算民众建议控制枪支,或者修改拥有枪支条文,甚至更严厉执行枪支法案,但罪犯依然可通过非法途径如黑市购得枪支。因此,政府机构应从合法及非法获得枪支角度来制裁枪支的猖狂,以便能更有效地减少枪击案造成的伤亡。

该网民指出,美国只有4%的枪击死亡案件可归因于心理健康问题,拥有高自杀率的国家中枪击案发生率往往较低,即心理健康问题与大规模枪击事件没有联系。其中不少人将枪击案的频繁发生归咎于暴力游戏及暴力电影的泛滥,然而,事实并非如此。该网民说,美国人民对于枪击案的发生似乎已习以为常,因为其发生率远比其他国家高出许多,然而,这并不代表美国人民较喜爱暴力游戏及电影。

非执法人员是否应拥有枪支

美国总统特朗普提议解决美国校园枪击案的方法是校园内的老师应拥有枪支,因为这可在枪击案发生时减少死伤人数,并提及允许航空公司飞行员携带和隐藏枪支已证明这项措施可能会取得成功。

接受访问的匿名网民提及,于Florida枪击案中,橄榄球教练Aaron Feis以自己的身体作为盾牌保护学生而牺牲,因此若老师拥有枪支,该教练也许可将肇事者射伤,挽救许多生命。

执法人员如警员拥有枪支这点是毫无争议的,因为他们为大众服务,为了公众的安全,他们拥有枪支是应该的。那非执法人员,即平民,是否应拥有枪支呢?若非执法人员拥有枪支,延伸出的安全问题必然不少,但在这治安问题严重的社会里,为了自卫,枪支是否是个必需品?

不少民众支持非执法人员应拥有枪支,因为他们认为枪支可以让他们遇上危险时自卫。1979年一调查显示,当他人知晓一位女性拥有枪支,就不会对她采取暴力或强暴,因而企图强奸案的机率就少于4%。由此可见,拥有枪支可保护较弱的群体,间接地减少犯罪机率。

拥有枪支乃人权非特权

根据研究资料,75%至80%的警员在接到案件投报10至15分钟后方抵达现场,这令罪犯有充足的时间逃脱。 因此,拥有枪支让民众可以在警员未抵达现场时而性 命受威胁的情况下自卫,减少死亡率。

此外,拥有枪支是美国民众的人权,而非一种特权。 该匿名网民表示,虽然英国有着一套严厉的枪支法规,他们的犯罪率依然快速地攀升。

除了枪械,罪犯在犯案时也使用各种鋒利的厨具和武器等,这亦造成极严重的伤亡。比如California的枪支条规是美国所有州属里最为严厉的,然而罪案依然频繁发生,因为罪犯们的枪械源头是从非法枪支售卖商取得。

另外,文化差异亦是非执法人员应拥有枪支的问题之一。虽然日常生活里枪支一般不会被使用,但若某人职业乃猎人或比赛枪手,他们也许每日都需要枪支为执行任务或公干。

虽然如此,尚有不少民众大力反对非执法人员应拥有 枪支。他们认为,人类未能为自己的行为负责任,而 如今枪支似乎已垂手可得,若不加强管制,犯案机率 只可能有增无减。

假如因为要让民众自卫,更多国家开放让民众申请枪 支拥有许可证,那同样也促使罪犯更易通过合法途径 获得枪支犯案。

除此之外,拥有良好精神健康的公民亦可能因某事受 激而犯下突如其来的枪击案。

据Washington Post网站统计,那153位枪手当中,一些行为原先正常,直至犯案。人们极度生气时亦可能犯下让他后悔的事情,而若某公民因一时冲动而将他人杀了,除触犯谋杀罪刑,他往后的日子也不会好过,重则甚至引发精神疾病,因为自己杀了人。



扬言扫射学校,是玩笑吗?

在美国校园枪击案一再发生,民众如惊弓之鸟之际,有一位在美国留学的台湾少年孙安佐,因为恐吓同学说"5月1日不要来学校,那天要来学校开枪扫射"而被告发,在4月27日晚遭警方拘捕。警察搜索他的住所后,发现了不少可疑物品如军式防弹背心、7枝弓箭、AK-47与AR-15的支架和1600多发子弹等。

年仅18岁的孙安佐是台湾艺人孙鹏与狄莺的儿子,他们得知儿子出事后立即飞往美国救子。他们表示儿子孙安佐只不过在学校和同学开玩笑,虽然他从小就很喜欢枪和武器,但他从来没用"开枪"威胁任何人。然而孙安佐就因一句"玩笑",除了被就读的高中开除,还拘留在美国Penn州Drahashire Prison监狱,面临繁琐漫长的官司。

拥枪禁枪没定案

骇人的枪击案,每每都掀起一番争议。然而,这一番 舌战并没有带来巨大及有效的变动,枪击案依然频繁 发生。这就好比永远不能解决的问题,并一直重复发 生。

一些人认为枪支控制应严加执行,因为执法人员拥有枪支便已足够;一些却坚信枪支控制并非有效,而拥有自卫武器乃人基本的权利。而你,认同哪一方的观点呢?

此外,对于枪击案于美国频繁发生,傅老师表示,因为美国开放让人民申请枪支拥有许可证,枪支的滥用程度亦会随之提高,而罪犯也可更容易地获得枪支。她指出,执法人员或需枪支为辅助工作的特定人员配枪即可,因为自卫的方法尚有好几种,人们其实不需要枪支自卫。

习其实没起到太大的作用。因为这些枪手亦受过相似的训练。因此,这些枪手便另寻方法引诱学生到教室外,像最近发生枪击案的美国高中,枪手拉响火警警钟,让学生涌出教室,然后对着学生开枪扫射,使到伤亡惨重。

她说,非执法人员不应拥有枪支,因为拥有枪支便是枪击案发生的主因。若不能通过合法途径拥有枪支,其枪击案的发生率亦会减少许多。虽然罪犯尚可通过非法途径获得枪支,但随着合法枪支的减少,获得枪支会艰难许多。

对于老师被允许拥有枪支及进行自卫培训这点,她 指出,若一个人拥有枪支,便可开枪伤人,尽管他 是位老师。



处罚,就是对犯错的人加以惩治。

在教育界老师对学生施行的惩罚可分为两种:体罚和精神与心理惩罚。 惩罚的方式在大马教育界一直以来是常见,虽然教育部也规定教师不可对学生采取体罚的行为, 但近年来老师过度惩罚学生事件一再发生,而师长采取以暴易暴的报复行动也备受争议。 因此,如果学生犯错,到底该不该惩罚学生?

老师惩罚学生原因何在? 方法是否正确?

用爱的教育来教育学生

爱的教育是一种倡导对孩子施予温情关怀的管教方式。爱的教育是替代体罚教育的最佳选择。老师打骂学生,不如先了解他们的背后故事,再以合理与温和的方式改正学生的过错,让管教以一种创意的方式 松化,并给予学生一个在充满爱的环境学习成长。然种教育方式也可以避免体罚所造成的心灵创伤。然而,爱的教育易让学生自我意识膨胀而不接受他人的批评和管教,进而变得霸道无礼,最后受到最大危害的还是自己。

韩中调整惩罚方式

自从大马教育部实施禁止学校对学生们实行惩罚后, 我校已尽量减少体罚学生。校方唯一实行的体罚教育 就是鞭打,但只有校长、副校长和训导主任才有权力 对学生施行此惩罚。

倘若学生触犯了校规如逃课、没有定时交功课等,老师将会给予劝告,让学生拥有一个纠正的机会。要是学生还是屡劝不听,他将会被训导主任鞭打或记录在纪律文件簿里。

然而,训导主任必须获得学生或家长的准许才能在训导处里鞭打学生。训导主任不被允许在大众面前鞭打学生,以免对学生带来心灵上的创伤,造成永久的伤害。

陈训导:学生应学会自律

学校就像国家一样有法律,有规则。训导主任陈帝荣老师认为,体罚教育与爱的教育的议论并不是哪一方法较有效的问题,而是它对哪种人会有较大的影响。有些心态较脆弱的学生无法接受体罚教育,而一部分强硬固执并不听劝告的学生就非实行体罚教育不可。陈训导表示,学校的每一位老师都担任着训导的职责。老师应该为班级设定严格的规则,才能为学生给予良好的学习环境。

身为一位训导主任,陈老师表示并不会因为学生一时犯错而针对任何学生,也不会把它留在心上。陈主任对学生最大的期望就是希望他们学会如何处理自己的事务,学会自律,让学校的名誉能有效的提升。

教师与家长应多沟通

总而言之,体罚是一把双刃剑。倘若用得正确、适当,就可以让学生改正自己的错误,走在光明的人生轨道上;如果用错了受伤的不仅是学生,还会伤及老师以及家长。这就需要让学校教师多与家长交流应该采取什么方式来教育犯错的学生,才能最有效的达到教育孩子的目的。



为什么学习更通常《本》?

"要不是我粗心写错这个字,就能得A了!"

考试成绩公布时,到处都能听见学生们握着试卷,发出类似的感叹。

几乎每位学生、老师,尤其是家长都对学生们在考试中考获A等成绩或高分都心怀着无限的向往, 以致学生们经常为获得高分,以满足老师和家长们对自己的期望。

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教育不知何时已是以学生的考试成绩作为成功的标签,成为了学生们为高分而学习,为名誉与威望而奋斗的代名词,若学生们无法考获A等佳绩,就会普遍被认定为自己的常识与学问是比别人差一等的。因此,这导致了现代的学生们忽视了学习的本意,只在乎考卷上大写的红色号码,成为为分数而读的孩子。

为什么人人都要A?

在大众眼里广泛流传的"好成绩=好大学=好工作好前途"的刻板印象,一直在求学过程中影响着学生的学习目的,这句经常被师长挂在嘴边的口头禅造就是决定未来的唯一标准"的错误对念,使学生们产生"只要我考到A,以后就能找到好不是,成为一名成功人士"的想法。这并不是学生们的错,因为他们从小就被分数局限,决定自己已进行的错,因为他们从小就有了一个大人,是受什么样的教育、与老师及同学们对自己已经,是好孩子还是坏孩子,是聪明的孩子还是差劲的孩子。

不仅如此,就连高等大学都是以学生们在学业上的成绩而录取学生,这一切都使学生们切真确实地体会分数的重要性。此外,师长们对于成绩好的学生们评价一直都比较好,因此平时会在其他学生们面前有心无意地偏袒他们,比如当他们犯错时,老师往往都会睁一只眼闭一只眼;反而是当成绩差的学生犯错时,都会被放大检视,连学习成绩和品行也一齐责骂。这些看似理所当然的却最伤学生们的心灵和自尊心。

另外,老师与家长们时常将学生与另一名学生进行比较,比较谁的名次比较高、谁拿比较多A、谁获得的奖杯比较多等,这也在无形中导致了学生们爱互相一较高下,时时刻刻都在追求高分的现象,仅仅是因为学生们不想被谁打败,只有成为"最好"才会避免成为在被拿来进行比较时占下风的一方。

褒? 贬? 何者居多?

人对于知识的追求应是无穷无尽的,但学习并不等于一定得在各个考试中追求全A,或是接近90至95之间

的高分。学生们在追求获得高分的过程中会发奋图强,自动自发地学习,甚至是养成勤勉好学的个性,而获得全A之后也会被其他学生们封为"学霸"或是"学神",享尽其他朋友的崇拜或钦佩及师长的赞赏。虽然追求优异的成绩应被每位学生效仿,但对于高分的痴迷却容易导致学生们忽略了自己在其他领域的才艺或专长的培养,这并不利于学生的成长,以致学生们只会追求高分的成绩。

A等成绩应是终身目标吗?

为了学习效果的分数而盲目拼劲全力,忽略长期的在学业上的锻炼,值得吗?即使是在考试中获得了全A成绩而在短暂的时间内获得了自足感,但一旦随着学生时代的结束,曾经的莘莘学子也不用再时时面临考试的刺激,对于把全A视为终身目标的学生难免产生茫然的感觉,似乎人生中没有什么可以再次放手一搏地追了。

有鉴于此,把追求A列为学习的唯一目标是不可取的。相反的,所谓"活到老,学到老",学习是一定要终身进行的,至于成果如何,是A是B,并不比过程中所吸取的知识更为重要。我们不应该把自己局限在分数的躯壳里,只要把该知道的都知道,无论成果好坏与否,并不是那么要紧了。

代沟4: 科技的应用

科技的日益发达造就了年轻一代在年幼时便已接触网络(Internet)。这一代,所谓的"Generation Z"(13至21岁左右),因渴望获得同辈的认可而在社交网站上载自己到外时的照片等。年轻一代认为,通过在社交网站上上载自己的照片,他们可以扩大自己

的社交圈子,并且提升自己的知名度。

因此,他们外出时必定让自己的朋友或亲人为他们拍照,并在外出后上载该照片(可能超过一张)。

当中某些年轻一辈甚至每日上载照片,更新自己的社交网页,并标上#00TD(Outfit Of The Day),即表示那是当天的穿着,或上载当天所享用的食物等。一般家长认为这含带着炫耀及攀比成份,使他们较反对儿女自拍或上载食物的照片。



以上所述年轻一代或年老一辈所喜爱的事物并非所有有关人士所爱,纯粹以多数为定,若有相异之处莫怪。

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我国卫生部及教育部于1月30日公布了学校食堂的全新指令, 禁止学校食堂售卖13种对学生身心无益、不健康的食物。

而在这13种禁售食物里,包括食堂普遍售卖及学生酷爱的汉堡包、炸鸡块、炸薯条及鱼丸鱼饼等。 随着禁令的颁布, 也代表这些受中小学生欢迎的食物将绝迹于学校食堂内。

据卫生部的报告,决定禁售这些食物的主要原因在于避免学生摄入过多的脂肪和盐分, 减少患上高血压、心脏病及患有肥胖问题的学生人数, 以及灌输学生从小培养良好及均衡饮食习惯的知识。

它们是哪些食物呢?

以往,卫生部将学校食堂售卖的食物 分成三大类,即"允许"、"不鼓 励"及"禁止",而现今,食物只 有"允许"与"禁止"两种组别。卫 生部与教育部禁售的食品组别包括过 期食品、加工食品(薯条、汉堡包、 肉丸、沙爹等)、含有玩具的零食、 无益的零食(薯片、虾饼等)、糖果 及巧克力、加工腌制食品 (腌制芒 果、洋葱等)、快熟食品(含有奶油 及糖分的食品、含有米粉、拉面、汤 等)、冰淇淋与冰糖食品、三合一即 冲式饮品 (三合一咖啡、拉茶等)、 能量饮料与水果口味饮料(少于35% 水果含量)、茶和咖啡及含有酒精的 饮品与食品。

此外,食堂被允许贩卖的食品与饮料 则包括新鲜蔬菜与沙拉、不含附加物 的食品(如全麦面包)、低糖水果(西瓜、白兰瓜、哈密瓜等)以及营养 价值高的饮料 (麦片、纯牛奶及矿泉 水)。

反响如何?

这项禁令遭到某些饮食营业者的不 满,纷纷向卫生部及教育部发声希望 能收回禁令。虽然这项禁令已发出, 但真正遵守并执行该禁令的学校却少 之又少。

虽然颁布此禁令的目的全在于培养学 生们健康的饮食习惯,但从小吃到大 的食物忽然绝迹于学校食堂, 未免会 引起一部分学生的不适, 反响可谓褒 义参差。

YouTube: the second-most popular site in the world, and the most popular video-sharing website in the world — if you haven't heard of it, you've most likely been living under a rock.

YouTube is firmly established as online viewers' first call for music videos, makeup tutorials, unattractive people documenting their more attractive lives, and men screaming at games. It is a platform where ideas come to life, where voices big and small are represented equally; where creators prosper, and where audiences rejoice.

And the thing about YouTube's audience is that it is large — in fact, the largest in the world for a video sharing platform, and the creator community isn't exactly small either. That means big things that happen on YouTube usually translates to big things that happen elsewhere both on the internet and in real life.

An undeniable fact about YouTube is the amount of influence it possesses over the general public. With thousands of self-proclaimed 'influencers' and a few hundred de facto ones, the influence of YouTube is beyond debate. From more trivial trends like squiggly eyebrows to more sinister movements like misinformation with motives, YouTube is capable of doing more than most expect.

CELEBRITIES

Justin Bieber, once the prodigal Canadian talent discovered on YouTube aged twelve, had now became a gossip column fodder. Innumerable artists have since followed Bieber's lead, using YouTube to share their work directly with an online audience, leaving talent agents and other traditional gatekeepers to fame scrambling to catch up.

By nurturing a devoted audience on YouTube, Bieber also paved the way for a new breed of celebrity: the intensely accessible and 'normal' person who can earn a six figure salary by sharing their thoughts and hobbies online.

The first YouTube celebrities emerged from viral one-hit wonder videos, like Charlie-Davies-Carr, the baby who famously bit his brother's finger in 2007 and earned his parents more than RM1.7 million from advertising revenue

and merchandise in the process. Tabatha Bundesen gave up her day job to manage her pet, Grumpy Cat. Today, the cat has a net worth of US\$100 million (RM389 million). There are YouTube celebrities in all manner of niche fields. DC Toys Collector is an "unboxer"; she unwraps new toys. Her video of five Angry Birds eggs being opened has been viewed 90 million times. Tanya Burr has earned 2.7 million subscribers by giving makeup tips. Nearly half a million people have watched Abby Vapes showing how to smoke an e-cigarette like a dragon. Others, such as the blue-eyed Briton Marcus Butler, American LGBT advocate and Tyler Oakley, are famous just for talking.

VIDEO GAMES

Fourteen years ago, few predicted that gamers would be the most followed people on the fledgling video site. But YouTube's most popular channel of all is that of PewDiePie — a.k.a. Felix Kjellberg — a 25 year-old Swede who offers profane, hyperactive commentary while playing horror and comedy games. PewDiePie's channel has 60 million subscribers and counting.

The concept— watching other people playing video games—has had many baffled, but, as Mark Turpin, the CEO of the Yogscast points out, "video is the best way to find out about a video game – to watch it being played. The layer on top of that is the personalities—entertainers— that people want to spend time with." YouTube's gamers engage their audience as if they were friends, and their audience love them for it, regardless of what variety may think.

The rise of video streaming on YouTube has lead to a major rethink in new game consoles. Both Sony's PlayStation 4 and Microsoft's Xbox One now offer the ability to share gameplay online at the touch of a button. The industry is becoming more savvy about using YouTube to its advantage. PlayStation Access, for example, is a YouTube channel offering irreverent videos such as "Six multiplayer

games that will tear your friendship apart", largely free of the corporate stuffiness you might expect from an "official" source. They're a clear attempt at capturing the spirit of gamer channels.

Getting featured on a prominent YouTube channel can catapult obscure games to mainstream success. In 2012, the British independent developer Mike Bithell released Thomas Was Alone, a minimalist puzzle-platform game that saw reasonable sales. However, once it was featured by YouTube channels, the amount of money the game made had doubled in a week, taking it "from a hobby to quit-the-day job type stuff".

LEARNING

Salman Khan, a YouTube superstar, is on a mission to bring a world-class, customised education to anyone, anywhere, for free. To do that, he has spent a good part of the last decade in the closet — literally — making around 5,000 videos about maths and science.

A decade ago, he was a young hedge fund analyst with a 12-year-old cousin who had fallen behind in maths. He was in Boston, she was in New Orleans, so he began tutoring her remotely, using Yahoo!'s Doodle notepad.

Soon, he started making videos. In them, Khan talks through a concept with the aid of bright numbers on a black screen. His voice is earnest yet informal, the videos are spare and efficient; none is longer than 10 minutes, plus his cousin could pause the lesson, or re-watch the parts she didn't understand. They feel exactly like getting a private lesson from a whizz of an older brother.

In 2006, a friend convinced him to post his videos on YouTube. Within weeks, strangers were watching the videos, too. Five years later, he quit his job to work full-time on Khan Academy, the non-profit he founded off the back of his YouTube success. Today, Khan Academy has 15 million registered students in 190 countries, and the YouTube channel has racked up over 500 million views. While Khan is perhaps YouTube's biggest success in the field of learning, the platform is saturated with instructional videos. There are YouTube tutorials for changing a light bulb, assembling baby buggies, learning the guitar. Shawn Mendes, the 16-year-old Canadian singer hailed as the "next Justin Bieber" taught himself guitar entirely via YouTube.

FOR BETTER OR WORSE?

YouTube is undeniably influential in the making of today, it could be positive or negative. However, it is mostly based on how contents are taken in by the viewers, since the decision are theirs to make. Many YouTubers upload opinionated videos on current events from their perspective, and if viewers agree with what is shown, they would be influenced. All and all, YouTube is a platform where original content creators congregate alongside aspiring singers and crying man-babies is not the most common sight on the internet, and the little quirks it brings has changed the world in unprecedented ways. As YouTube continues to grow, the world watches tentatively as its hands shape the future.





人工智能是否会取代人类?

谷歌人工智能AlphaGo

谷歌人工智能AlphaGo是因应电脑围棋发展计划而生产的科技,于2014年由英国的Google DeepMind所开发。"AlphaGo"的"Go"为日文"碁"字发音转写,是围棋的西方名称;而当中的"Alpha"则为领导或佼佼者之义。

顾名思义, AlphaGo的创造者希望它成为围棋界的高手之一, 并探讨人工智能(Artificial Intelligence) 是否在某些程度上可媲美人脑, 甚至超越人脑。

AlphaGo使用了Monte Carlo tree search (一种用于决策过程的启发式搜索算法)及deep learning网路相 (是一种试图使用包含复杂结构对数据进行高层抽象的算法)结合,使其可以像人类大脑般自发学习,大幅度提高其下棋实力。

2016年3月,AlphaGo对决韩国围棋九段棋手暨世界顶级围棋棋手李世石,引起全世界的密切关注,并于4场比赛取得胜利,最终,李世石成为AlphaGo手下败将。

而当中原因为AlphaGo接受deep learning网路训练,背后更是有谷歌Deep Mind专家的不断调整,使其不休息也可在最好的状态下对战。

除此之外,它并不会受到外界的干扰如情绪的影响。 相反的,李世石是人类,思考的速度及计算能力远远 不及电脑的迅速及精准,亦会受到外界的干扰及情绪 波动的影响,使其败下阵来。虽然李世石最终被打 败,但他还是为人类扳回一城,赢得5场比赛中的一 场比赛。 AlphaGo的横扫千军之势令人震惊,不少网络棋手败在AlphaGo的"升级版"手下,神话般地创造了60盘全胜的记录。

此外,中国围棋职业九段棋手柯洁于2017年5月向谷歌人工智能AlphaGo挑战,并以0:3的成绩落败。起初以0:2落败后,他仔细寻找AlphaGo下棋时的漏洞以争取打败AlphaGo的机会。

然而,AlphaGo使出了令人意想不到的招数,打败了名列世界第一的柯洁。同于5月,5位围棋世界冠军周睿羊、时越、唐韦星、芈昱廷、陈耀烨联手挑战AlphaGo,令人意外的是,五位世界冠军的联手也不敌AlphaGo。

回顾历史Deep Blue

前西洋棋世界冠军Garry Kasparov于1997年被超级电脑(IBM supercomputer)Deep Blue打败,这象征着人工智能的崛起,引起全世界的高度关注。这项赛事甚至被编成纪录片《The Man vs. The Machine》。

Garry Kasparov指出,失败的原因极可能是因Deep Blue于赛事当中所作出牺牲以顾全大局的一步。对他及其他专家来说,这一步以人工智能的程度来说过于复杂,似乎存在着人为干预。

15年后, Deep Blue的设计师之一Murray Campbell指出, 当时决定性的一步是因Deep Blue程序里出现的一个失误, 当时的它因不晓得该如何继续行下一步而随机选择了最终"决定性"的一步。

人工智能的崛起

苹果公司的"Siri",谷歌的"Google Now",微软的"Cortana"等等均为虚拟个人助理(Virtual Personal Assistant),它们透过各用户帐号为各用户提出建议,视该应用程序的使用频率而"猜测"用户下一步会打开或下载那些软件等,为人类带来不少方便。

用户亦可利用它们为更有效的寻找希望打开的文件或应用程序。此外,电脑游戏亦编入了人工智能,以提升玩家的游戏经历,令玩家更为过瘾。各游戏如"Middle Earth: Shadow of Mordor"、"Far Cry"、"Call of Duty"等均具备人工智能设置。谷歌所进行的无人驾驶车计划亦是靠人工智能生效的。谷歌利用所编程的人工智能,将其植入车子内,该人工智能将视路况而决定如何行驶等。

购买预测亦使用了AI,以预测顾客群的需求。但这人工智能的进步因存在着隐私侵犯的危险而令人担忧。另外,AI被用于欺诈识别,即用于银行内,在大量信息内挑出可能的欺诈活动,并通知银行用户。万能的在线客户支持亦是靠AI运转的,一些网站可供客户与在线客户支持代表谈话,而这些"在线客户支持代表"便是人工智能编程。

随着人类对新闻生产速度的要求越来越快,AP,Fox和Yahoo!都使用AI编写简单的文稿,如财务摘要,体育回顾,以及体育报告等。AI只负责编写简单的文稿,复杂的专访、专题等并不是由它们编写。

AI可24小时无休地监控,并在发现可疑事情时及时通知警卫。AI亦可在人类娱乐方面提供协助,如据客户所表达的兴趣作判断推荐音乐或电影,供客户欣赏。智能家庭设备亦使用了人工智能,它们具备自学的能力,并通过调整恒温器或其他设备为客户节省金钱及能源。在这科技进步的时代,AI无处不在,并且每天都在改善我们的生活。

人工智能可能推翻人类?




I recently came across an incredibly compelling read -Ways To Live Forever. This well written debut of Sally Nicholls handled the sensitive topic of terminal illness flawlessly by perfectly capturing the poignancy of it. This book narrates Sam McQueen's everyday life about living with leukaemia. Because of his illness, Sam was homeschooled with his best friend Felix and made a list of ambitious things he wanted to do. This book shares his deeply humorous yet saddening story about friends, family, conflict, and death.

The novel's main protagonist was undoubtedly a complex character, an innocent child who experienced the thrill in riding airships, the daunting anticipation of death, and the heart-wrenching sorrows of farewells. However, my favourite character was Felix, who Sam fatefully met at a hospital, since he suffers from cancer as well. The fedora-loving thirteen-year-old was a realist, mischievous and witty, with a great sense of humour. He often encouraged Sam to do the things he loved, and was the main driving force for Sam to achieve his to-do list. What I liked about him was mostly his personality, and as I quote from the book, "He never thought anything was impossible."

In my opinion, the character with the most development was definitely McQueen's father. Though a father of a dying child, he rarely showed much emotion -- or vulnerability -- around his son. Contrary to Felix, he couldn't seem to accept the impending death of his own son, so he immersed himself in lots of work. As the story progresses, his father began to show how tender-hearted

and fatherly he is, which is all you need to see through this mysterious character.

The genre of this book was not in fact about a treacherous journey, a strong-willed protagonist, a menacing villain or a magical discovery. Instead, it was simply a slice of life story. Snippets of Sam's life are pieced together to form a wholly representation of his life and perspective, and the best part is -- if you can read the chapters over and over again, or randomly, it still stays coherent. Apart from the interesting layout, plot and characters, Nicholls' writing style was also an important element which really brought the book together. Though blunt and barely consisting of fancy vocabulary, it was powerful and moving nonetheless. Personally, I felt that the book had conveyed lots of different messages, no matter if it's through simple sentences, through foreshadowing or through chapters and chapters of plots, there are so many thought-provoking themes to discover. Upon finishing the last chapter, I remembered thinking about how unfair life appears to be, but that's just the way it's supposed to be. Giving it more thought, I realised that it doesn't really matter how long you really live, but how you live. In the book, Sam spent the last few months of his life in the most fulfilling ways ever, and sometimes that's the "forever" we all ever need. Way too often this book may have you enjoying its honest humour and nodding at its insightfulness, but it may also bombard you with heart-wrenching emotions that are guaranteed to move you to tears. I certainly enjoyed this enchanting read, and I'm sure you will too.

The Appeal of Tragedy

Tragedy, from the Greek word tragoidia, is classically defined as a form of drama that presents human suffering in a dignified manner. Most modern tragedies deviate from this; according to Dr. Michael Scott, a key differentiating characteristic is that modern tragedies definitely have sad endings, while classical tragedies will always pose a moral question.

Tragedies have enjoyed mass appeal throughout the centuries. Today, we will look at both traditional and modern reasons for appreciating tragic stories.

The Greek philosopher Aristotle believed that tragedy creates catharsis, a form of emotional relief. Catharsis "cleanse(s) the heart through pity and terror, purging us of our petty concerns and worries by making us aware that there can be nobility in suffering". In the Greek tragedy, Ajax, the titular character commits mass-murder in a fit of anger. Coming to his senses, he realises horrifically that his honour as a soldier is forever stained. By the end of the play, he atones for his sins through suicide- reclaiming his dignity in death. Catharsis is gained by the viewer by appreciating the strength of Ajax's moral character (and not the act of suicide!) as Ajax shows that one can be honourable even when suffering.

Another way of looking at the appeal of tragedy that some people simply like dark stories. Story telling encompasses various personal preferences of different people. Some people just prefer darker stories as they relate to the struggles they face. This is somewhat therapeutic- they don't feel alone in their daily battles, that someone else is facing the same battles as well.

The reason why some people prefer these stories could be the realist nature of tragedies. This is because the harsh realities of life are often neglected for the sunshine and rainbows of idealistic, happy endings. This prevalent theme of nitty-gritty suffering is a wake-up call to return to reality, as life is a constant struggle against the forces of fate. Hence, the theme of human struggle and suffering depicted through the endless challenges faced by the characters is relatable and down to earth. Themes of failure, disappointment and regret are meaningful, as everyone will have faced these issues at some point of time. Tragedy reminds us that people are infalliable, and that every person is striving in their own way to come to terms with these. This is why "dark" superhero movies like "Deadpool" are popular, because people want to see superheroes with an ambiguous moral code just like every other human being.

From an emotional perspective, it could be that audiences are piqued by the constant juggle between despair and hope. For people who yearn for stories that are emotionally provoking, the genre of tragedy is very effective in this particular technique. This method of writing stimulates the audience, through the juxtaposition of happier moments to sad ones, to experience a fuller range of emotions. Also, a lot of mainstream films are traditionally "feel-good" films that aim to make audiences laugh- so people flock to tragedy because it allows them to express the feeling of sadness that they don't often get to experience. Tragedy ultimately gives people an excuse to cry when they want to.

From a psychological perspective, some people find pleasure- schadenfreude in the suffering of others, be it our friends or our enemies. Although this sounds sadistic, schadenfreude is not necessarily a bad thing. The author Joseph Shrand believes that schadenfreude is deeply rooted in our human nature- it adheres to the human condition. It is a human thing to feel a sense of relief and happiness when someone else suffers, and we are devoid of harm. Schadenfreude makes us feel better precisely because we are able to escape the pain that the main characters are forced to experience. By way of pity, empathy and relief, we are able to have just a little more appreciation and gratefulness about the fact that we are leading peaceful lives.

This sense of reassurance also helps get rid of insecurities or paranoia that we feel in life when we watch the bad guy getting his deserved end-justifying that "bad things happen to people because of so and so reason". For example, when we watch stereotypical horror films where characters split up to explore a haunted house- we are reassured that a crazy axe-wielding serial killer will not appear to murder us, for we are not that naïve nor stupid enough to split up. Finally, in an artistic sense, tragedies provide a meaning, a perspective to be analysed. Perhaps this is why Greek and Shakespearean tragedies are often the subject of academic study, and integrated into the curriculum of many countries. Greek tragedies, for instance, offers insight into the belief of the ancient Greeks. Hamartia, the fatal flaw of the hero is an important literary device to be analysed to decipher the moral values each story intends to impart, as the Greeks had a rigid moral code to follow.

Therefore, tragedy is not a bad thing! It is the refuge of the broken, the therapy of the realist. Ironically, tragedy provides us a great service- it is the public showcase of despair to help reduce our own despair. It is a mirror of our harsh reality that we gaze into for a deeper understanding of our lives and of ourselves.

Ultimately, the appeal of tragedy boils down to personal preference. For me, personally, I enjoy tragedy because I love to sit down, relax and be enticed by a tale with a firm grasp to reality. This is the appeal of tragedy, undoubtedly, my favourite genre.


"It's for your family's good!" Chick cried in between sobs. She also hated the fact she had to do this. To do this to the love of her life. But it wasn't a choice for her to make.


